Job Description

Chief of Police:

Bryn Athyn is a tiny jewel tucked in suburban Montgomery County, just outside of Northeast Philadelphia it covers an area of 1.9 square miles of mostly open space, with a population of roughly 1,400. Originally part of Moreland Township, in 1916 Bryn Athyn leaders petitioned the Commonwealth to become an independent community. Bryn Athyn became a Home Rule Municipality in 1979. It is home to the Bryn Athyn National Historic District and hosts four major historic buildings including the Bryn Athyn Cathedral. It is also home to Bryn Athyn College, Academy of the New Church Secondary Schools, Bryn Athyn Elementary, and is the headquarters of two Church organizations.

The position is an executive level, active-duty Chief position responsible for all Police Department personnel, programs, and services. The position is responsible for creating and implementing a progressive law enforcement program and addressing the public health and
